New partnership to boost community's "No Kill" efforts
Joint venture will help San Antonio "fix" the animal overpopulation problem

As San Antonio continues to strive towards becoming a "No Kill" community, Animal Care Services and SpaySA are focusing on the most effective ways to control our city's animal overpopulation issue and encourage responsible pet ownership. To that end, ACS and SpaySA are gearing up for a new program that will help owners keep their pets in these trying economic times in addition to reducing the number of roaming strays and lowering the community's pet euthanasia rate. With the City's sponsorship, SpaySA will now be offering at least one FREE clinic each month for local pet owners who would like to get their companion animal sterilized.
