Proposed renaming of the San Antonio Police Department's West Patrol Substation to the West Memorial SAPD Substation located at 7000 Culebra Road, San Antonio, Texas 78238.

• The City of San Antonio will conduct a public hearing to rename the West Patrol Substation on February 6, 2014, as required by Article XVI, Section 6 of the City Code. Comments, oral or written, concerning the renaming of the West Patrol Substation to West Memorial SAPD Substation from all interested citizens will be considered.

The renaming of the substation has been requested by Councilman Cris Medina, District 7, with the support of Councilman Ray Lopez, District 6. Councilman Medina felt the renaming of the substation was an appropriate way to honor all SAPD officers from the West Substation that have given the Utimate sacrifice for the citizens of San Antonio.
