Victim: Mario Martinez (55 years old) 08/20/1958
Location of offense: 4614 Howard St, San Antonio, Texas

Synopsis: On 01/03/2014 at approximately 9:42 p.m. the San Antonio Police Department responded to 4614 Howard St. for a report of a shooting (case # SAPD14002072). Responding officers discovered Mario Martinez inside his home suffering from a gunshot wound. Mario Martinez was watching television when the shots were fired into his residence. Mario was transported by EMS to the hospital but later died as a result of his wounds. Anyone with information related to the murder of Mario Martinez is asked to call Crime Stoppers at 224-STOP (7867).
