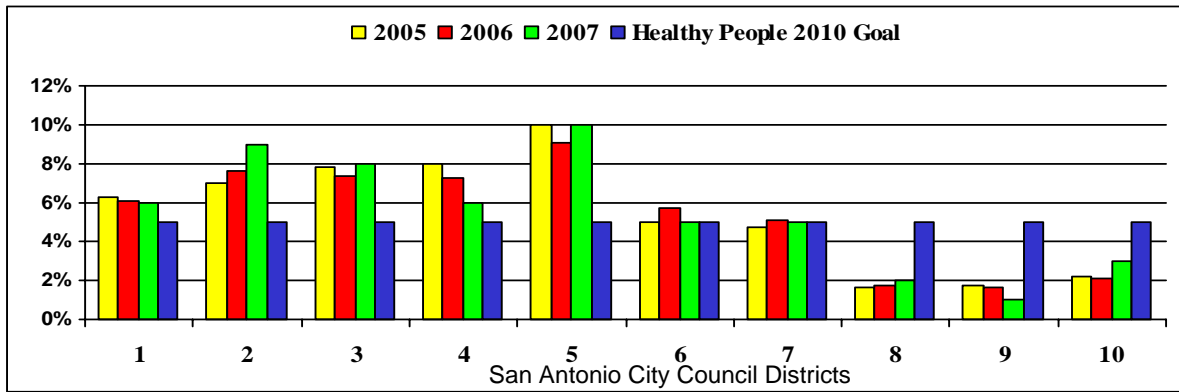


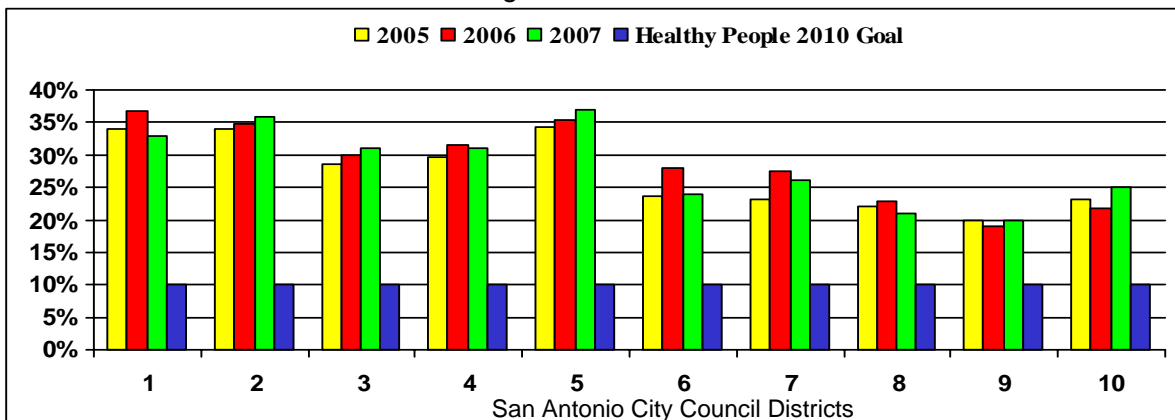
Maternal Health Indicators by San Antonio City Council District

Maternal Age < 18 as a Percentage of All Births



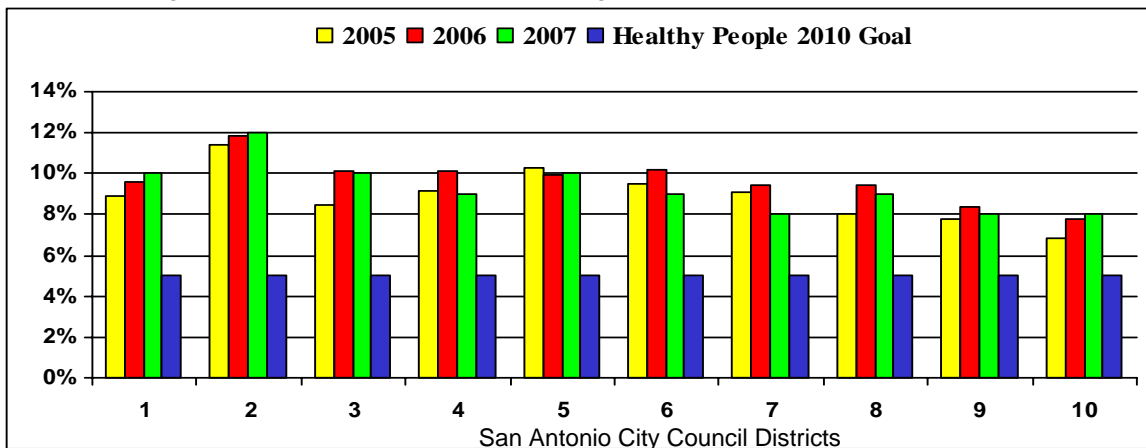
Healthy People 2010 Goal: no more than 5% of all births should be to mothers under 18

Low Birth Weight (<2500) Grams as a Percentage of All Births

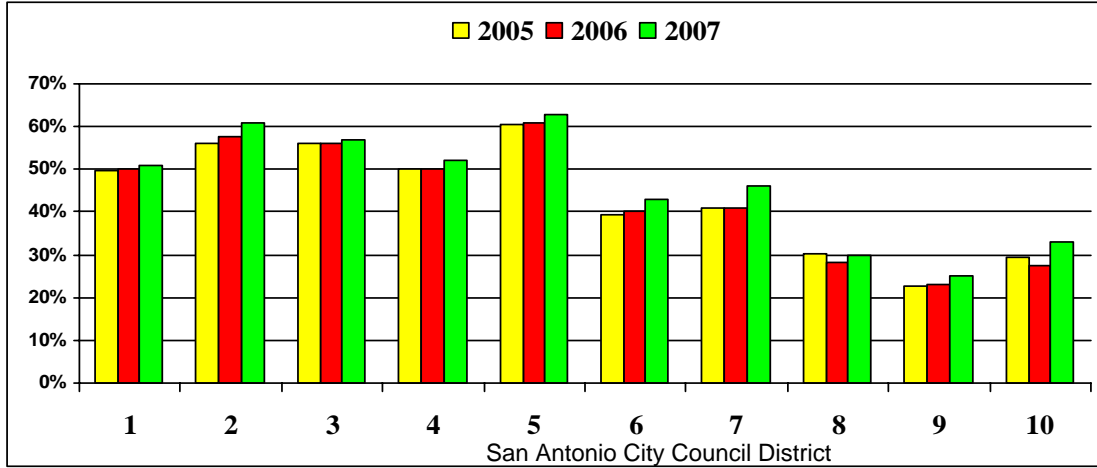


Healthy People 2010 Goal: at least 95% of live born infants weighing > 2,500 grams at birth

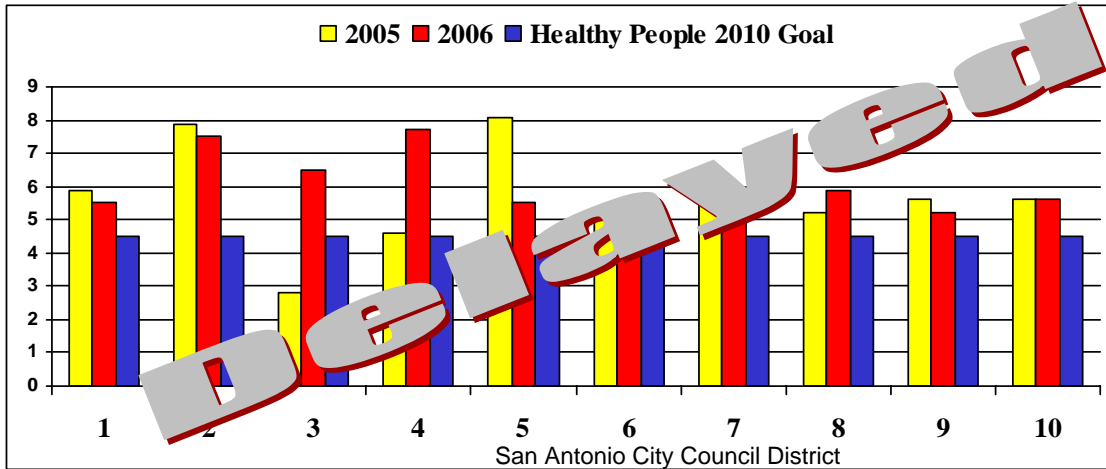
