

**Shall the City Charter be amended effective July 1, 2015 to increase compensation paid to the members of the City Council to \$45,755 (equal to the current established San Antonio Median Family Income ), and increase compensation of the mayor to \$65,755 (equal to the San Antonio Median Family Income +35%)?**

If adopted, the City Charter shall be amended as follows:

**Sec. 6. Compensation.**

(a) Each member of the council shall receive \$45,755 as compensation [for his services as such member the sum of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each meeting of the council attended, provided that the total of such compensation shall not exceed one thousand forty dollars (\$1,040.00) per annum;] and the mayor shall receive \$65,755 as compensation].

**As a separate proposition, if the above is approved by the voters, shall the City Charter be amended effective June 1, 2015 to provide for adjustments to Council compensation restricted to no more than the lesser of 2.5% or the Consumer Price Index?**

If adopted, the City Charter shall be amended to add subsection (b) as follows:

**Sec. 6. Compensation.**

(b) City council and Mayoral compensation shall be adjusted every two years and shall be restricted to an increase of no more than the lesser of 2.5% or the Consumer Price Index, published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics.

**Temporary provision:** The mayor and members of the City Council elected at the 2015 general election are eligible to receive this compensation.
