### TUESDAYS, WEDNESDAYS & THURSDAYS BUSY PARKING DAYS AT SAT

### PROJECT FAST FACTS

Currently and in the next few weeks, activity will continue on prepping the hourly garage to make way for new Public Parking and Consolidated Rental Car Facility at San Antonio International Airport. As summer travel season continues, SAT is seeing an increase in travelers especially on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. During these days, the Parking Garage may reach capacity. SAT has several other options for customers during these periods.

The Green Lot, SAT's most economical option is located one block north of the airport's entrance at Loop-410. The Green Lot's rates are prorated but are \$8.00 max per day. As with all SAT parking options, the Green Lot is serviced by free air conditioned shuttle buses that operate continuously on a 5-8 minute rotation. There are 4 covered shelters in the Green Lot for travelers to wait for the shuttle. Shuttles drop off travelers at the upper level curbside between Terminal A and B and upon arrival from their trip; travelers are picked up, lower level at the center island and taken back to the Green Lot.

The Red Lot, SAT's overflow lot is open only in the event that both the Garage and Green Lot reach capacity. Red Lot usage is rare but an available option during high peak travel days. Travelers will be directed to the Red Lot when necessary and shuttle bus service will be available.

Also, when picking up passengers, the Cell Phone Waiting Lot, located at the corner of Airport Blvd. and Northern Blvd, just off of Loop 410 is available for customers to park and wait for their party. The Cell Phone Waiting Lot gives motorists a free temporary area to wait until friends, family members or business associates deplaned, collect their baggage before calling to be picked up curbside.

With construction underway on the new parking facility, demand for parking spaces in the Parking Garage at San Antonio International is at an all-time high. SAT has seen an increase in parking demands and as a result, SAT is encouraging passengers to check parking availability on the airport's website prior to arriving at the airport.

Checking parking availability at the airport is easy and saves time. Simply visit the airport's website at [www.sanantonio-airport.com](http://www.sanantonio-airport.com), and view Parking Availability on the right side of the homepage.

If the parking option of choice is near full, travelers are encouraged to proceed directly to the next available option.

If both the Parking Garage and Green Lot are full, travelers will be directed to SAT's overflow parking option, the Red Lot.

With the hourly garage closed to make room for the new parking facility planning ahead is essential. Travelers are advised to arrive 2 hours before their scheduled flight to allow for parking, airline check-in and security processing.

Public parking in the new facility is scheduled to open in 2017.
