



San Antonio International Airport Opens Green Lot for Holiday Parking Save Money by Self Parking in the Green Lot

San Antonio, TX – (December 15, 2014) San Antonio International Airport opens the Green Lot in response to the need for budget minded parking over the holidays.

For passengers who are planning to fly out over the holidays this is a time and money saving choice. Travelers can plan ahead to self-park in the Green Lot rather than drive around the Long Term Parking Garage and then be redirected to a remote lot instead.

Remember to visit the SAT live data feed for parking availability on the airport's website and mobile site just as holiday travel ramps up. By visiting www.sanantonio-airport.com, users can immediately see the number of parking spaces available for all the parking options and plan accordingly prior to arriving at airport.

The "Green Lot" will be open beginning Monday, December 22nd and the cost for parking will be eight dollars a day. Green Lot parking is credit card only. Entrances are located off of Dee Howard and Northern Boulevard.

Customer service conveniences added within the last year for parking visitors include:

- **Credit Card Only Lanes:** Visitors paying by credit card can exit through any unattended lane. Look for the lanes with Credit/Debit Exit only signs above the lanes. Transactions processed through this method only take a few seconds and do not require patron signature.
- **Ticketless Options:** Your Credit card can become your ticket. Insert the same credit card upon entering and exiting and your transaction is fast and simple. This ticketless method eliminates having to keep track of a parking ticket while away on travel and assists in reducing wait time at exit.
