



Passenger Numbers Up at San Antonio International in January 2015

SAN ANTONIO, TX (March 27, 2015) -- San Antonio International Airport (SAT) announced a passenger increase of 1.3% for January 2015 compared to January 2014 and an even greater increase was recorded in international passenger count at 9.1%. The international passenger count was the highest ever recorded for January and included scheduled Mexican service and Canadian passenger charters. The total domestic passenger count is also up for SAT by 0.8%.

In 2014, San Antonio International Airport set a new record for total passengers and enplanements and surpassed the record count set in 2008. Additionally, SAT was awarded the first place ranking in the “Best Improvement By Region: North America” category for 2013 and 2014 in the Airport Service Quality (ASQ) Awards.

Operated by the City of San Antonio Aviation Department, SAT serves nearly 8.4 million passengers annually and ranks among the nation’s top gateways to Mexico offering nonstop service to 35 nonstop cities on 10 carriers, to include five international destinations with 60+ flights to Mexico.
