



Interjet Airlines Announces New Non Stop Service to Toluca

Service also included same plane service to Guadalajara

November 14, 2011—San Antonio, TX— Interjet, a Mexican based carrier, recently announced it will begin round-trip service between San Antonio (SAT) and Toluca (TLC), Mexico with a planned starting date of on December 6, 2011. The announcement was made during a media briefing with Interjet executives and Mayor Julián Castro of San Antonio.

The flight will be three days per week with nonstop service to Toluca and same plane service continuing to Guadalajara (GDL). The announcement comes on the heels of Interjet announcing for the first time serving a market in the United States, as it begins to grow its services in the United States.
