Terminal A Renovation Completion Draws Near

VISIBLE CHANGES TAKING SHAPE

A newly updated Terminal A is quickly emerging. Renovations to the 30-year old Terminal A are scheduled to be completed in May 2014. The \$35.6 million renovation project has entered the final phases with 17 gates, 6 set of restrooms and all-new airline ticket counters. Signage around the ticket counters and the lobby/visitor waiting room have also been completed. Crews

counters and the lobby visitor waiting room have also been completed. Crews continue to make progress on wall and ceiling treatments, updating fixtures and installing the new terrazzo floors.



The updates to both Terminal A food courts are now complete. The areas received new furniture, lighting fixtures and updated flooring. The food and retail shops in the terminal also received new store fronts. As part of the new concessions program managed by HMS HOST, Terminal A received 7 new stores, including La Gloria, Cinnabon/Auntie Anne's, The Fruteria and Mission Ice House. Under this same project, Famous Famiglia was closed temporarily for updates and is now open.



Significant progress has also been made in the baggage claim area with new floors, walls and ceiling. Updates to the HVAC and sprinkler systems are drawing toward completion while way-finding signage in Terminal A is making progress. To date, one set of escalators has been completed and the other two sets are closed as new equipment is installed. Work continues on the terminal's elevators.



The Terminal A renovation project is being funded through user fees, rents, airline rates and charges and no local tax dollars are being used to operate or pay for the project.
