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Creighton to be widened, reconstructed from Southcross to Griffin

District 5 City Councilman David Medina, City of San Antonio staff, and community members will celebrate the start of construction on the Creighton Avenue (Southcross Boulevard to Griffin Avenue) project.

A groundbreaking ceremony is scheduled for **10 a.m. Monday, October 15**, at 1402 La Quintana Restaurant parking lot, the corner of Creighton Avenue and Griffin Avenue (*see the attached map*).

This project will widen and reconstruct Creighton Avenue, from Southcross Boulevard to Griffin Avenue, from an existing 24-foot pavement width to 27-foot pavement width, as well as of installation concrete curb and gutters, driveway approaches, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant ramps and a 4-foot sidewalk on the east side of Creighton Avenue. The project also includes the construction of water, sanitary sewer and gas lines within the project limits.

On September 13, 2012, City Council awarded a construction contract for \$1,776,450 to EZ Bel Construction LLC. Of the total contract amount, \$781,441 will be funded through City's 2007 Bond Savings fund; \$651,581.32 will be reimbursed by San Antonio Water System; and \$343,428 will be paid by CPS Energy. Klotz Associates, Inc is the design consultant.

Construction is estimated for completion by August 2013.
