**Public Notice**

A Public Hearing will take place beginning at 9 a.m. on **Thursday, September 17, 2015** in the City Council Chamber, Municipal Plaza Building. This will be a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) required city-wide public hearing for a substantial amendment to the City's FY 2015 Consolidated Annual Action Plan/Budget to authorize a reprogramming in an amount not to exceed \$600,000 in Home Investment Partnership (HOME) funds from available multi-family set aside funds to support Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) Set Aside funds to develop new affordable single family homes.

A copy of the proposed action is currently available for review and comment on the City's website [www.sanantonio.gov/gma](http://www.sanantonio.gov/gma) through the date of the public hearing. This information also will be available for review and comment at the Department of Planning and Community Development's, Grants Monitoring and Administration Division located at 1400 S. Flores, Unit 3. Copies will also be located at the Department of Human Services located at 106 South St. Mary's Street, 7<sup>th</sup> Floor and the Central Library located at 600 Soledad.

Citizens wishing to speak at the public hearing may individually sign the appropriate sign-in sheet for that purpose which will be provided at the entrance of the City Council Chambers prior to 9 a.m. the day of the hearing. Each citizen will have three minutes to speak on one or multiple agenda items. Groups consisting of three or more citizens will be allotted nine minutes total to address the council on any one item.

This meeting site is wheelchair accessible. The accessible entrance is located at the Municipal Plaza Building/Main Plaza entrance. Accessible visitor parking spaces are located at City Hall, 100 Military Plaza, North side. Auxiliary aids and services, including Deaf interpreters, must be requested forty-eight (48) hours prior to the meeting.
