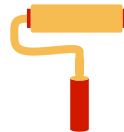

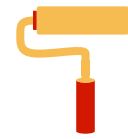

ABOUT THE POWER OF PRESERVATION FOUNDATION

The Power of Preservation Foundation (PoP) is a registered 501(c)3 whose mission is to support public education about the value of historic preservation as an economic development tool, provide hands-on, service learning opportunities, and fund the rehabilitation of historic buildings in and around San Antonio.

Established in 2012, PoP provides financial support for the hands-on preservation programs administered by the City of San Antonio Office of Historic Preservation (OHP) including the **S.T.A.R. Program** which matches student groups with historic homeowners to perform much needed home repair and maintenance. To date, the S.T.A.R. Program has improved over 100 homes in historic neighborhoods at zero cost to the homeowner.



San Antonio has a significant number of aging buildings and thousands of low to moderate income households who are struggling to keep up with simple repair and maintenance. At the same time, the number of skilled craftsmen who are specialized to work on historic and aging homes is rapidly decreasing. The **Rehabber Club** is an OHP program which seeks to build a network of skilled craftsmen and everyday citizens and provide them with the historic rehab know-how our community needs. Support not only provides a service to households in need; it is an investment in the future of San Antonio by providing a valuable educational experience for future contractors.
