This session will explore how to involve children in the writing process while modeling the connection between the spoken and printed word.</p>	<p>Audience: 1st-2nd Grade Developing Vocabulary</p> <p>Context clues, word meaning and word structure all play a part in helping children determine the meaning of unknown words. This session will explore teaching practices that will help promote children's ability to make meaning when reading unknown vocabulary words.</p>
