San Antonio B-cycle program to add several new stations

San Antonians are embracing the idea of alternate modes of transportation, so much so that the city's B-cycle bike-sharing program is expanding once again.

B-cycle plans to add 10 new stations in the Alamo City. The installation of those new outlets will begin on Aug. 19.

Once this latest expansion is completed, San Antonio will have 52 B-cycle stations and 420 bikes available for the city's ride-sharing program.
