




TEEN BIRTHS IN SAN ANTONIO • 2014



From 2010 to 2014 San Antonio experienced a **26% DECREASE** in the teen birth rate for females ages 15 to 19, **exceeding the SA2020 goal** of reducing the teen birth rate by 25% by the year 2020.

Based on the 2010 San Antonio teen birth rate of 50.6 births per 1,000.

TEEN BIRTH RATES • AGES 15 TO 19 BY ZIP CODE /SCHOOL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES




*There were no zip codes 4 times the U.S. Teen Birth Rate.

TEEN BIRTH RATES PER 1,000 FEMALES • AGES 15 TO 19








WAS THE 2014 TOTAL NUMBER OF BIRTHS TO FEMALES AGES 10 TO 19 IN SAN ANTONIO

2010 - 2014 TEEN BIRTHS • AGES 15 TO 19




TEEN MOTHERS • AGES 15 TO 19 WITH MORE THAN ONE CHILD
