



Intact Dog Permits- It's the LAW!

Effective January 1, 2009, any owner or keeper of a dog in the City of San Antonio that is not spayed or neutered must obtain an annual intact dog permit?*

**Exemptions exist for dogs that qualify for certified medical exceptions (from a licensed veterinarian) or dogs less than six months old. The new law does not apply to temporary or new residents. More details are available at www.saacs.net.*
