Competitive Grants Submitted

- COPS Hiring Grant
 - 100 Police Officers
- Southern Border Narcotics Grant
 - 17 Uniform Police Officers
- Byrne Memorial Competitive Grant
 - 6 Crime Analysts
- Violence Against Women Grant
 - \$500K for transitional housing for victims of domestic violence
- National Clean Diesel Funding Assistance Grant
 - \$3.6 M for 291 exhaust controls and 21 propane trucks

Neighborhood Stabilization Program

- Round 2 funding available through Recovery Act
- Amount for Nation is \$2 billion
- Available to local governments and non-profit developers to:
 - acquire land and property
 - to demolish or rehabilitate abandoned properties
 - to offer down payment and closing cost assistance to low-to middle-income homebuyers

Neighborhood Stabilization Program

- Stakeholders meeting on Friday, May 8
 - Non-Profit Housing Providers & City departments including Housing & Neighborhood Services, Community Initiatives, Planning & Development Services, and Environmental Policy
- ARRA Grant Application due July 17

Neighborhood Stabilization Program

- Round 1 funding made available through Economic Recovery Act of 2008
- San Antonio received Round 1 funding award of \$8.6 million
- Grant agreement executed on March 17th, 2009
- 54% of funds have been committed

- Coordination with Regional Partners to develop consolidated listing of all ARRA funds coming to area
 - Surrounding cities, counties, school districts, other agencies
