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**ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:**

The Alamodome was financed through a voter-approved tax increase and completed in May of 1993. A lawsuit was filed by residents who claimed contaminated Alamodome dirt was linked to high lead levels in nearby neighborhood soil. This gave rise to allegations that appropriate environmental assessment procedures had been ignored. The City of San Antonio filed a civil lawsuit in 1994. The case was settled out of court in 1996
