The Historic Preservation Officer was to administer the preservation ordinance and advise the Board for Historic Districts and Landmarks on each application that was to come before them. That person was also responsible for recommending structures, buildings, districts and sites for landmark designation and coordinating the city's preservation activities with those of state and federal agencies.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

This collection covers the Historic Preservation Officers records from the 1960's into the 1990's. The types of records contained in this collection include ordinances, surveys, meeting notes, legislation, zoning and various projects.
