ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

Edward Garza served two terms as mayor of the city of San Antonio from 2001-2005, previously serving as a representative for District 7 on the San Antonio City Council (1997-2001). As mayor, Garza focused on a number of significant economic development projects, most notably the CitySouth initiative, a plan to redevelop a 57 square mile area on San Antonio's Southside. The CitySouth initiative sought to attract Toyota's 6th North American manufacturing facility as part of a plan for sustainable, quality growth, while easing development pressures over Edwards Aquifer and congestion in the northern sector of the city. Garza was also involved with attempting a number of other large scale development ventures, including petitioning for the creation of a MLS soccer club, the creation of a San Antonio branch of Texas A&M University, and a controversial attempt to bring a PGA golf course to the city. Following the events of September 11, 2001, Garza collaborated with County Judge Nelson Wolff and District Attorney Susan Reed to create one of the nation's first comprehensive City-County emergency preparedness plans. Garza also served on a variety of local, state, and nation boards and committees, including the San Antonio Water

System; City Public Service; Texas Municipal League; Advisory Board of the National League of Cities (NLC) and as a member of the NLC's Nominating Committee; President of the Hispanic Elected Local Officials (HELO), a constituency group of the NLC; Board of Advisors of the National Association of Latino Elected and Appointed Officials (NALEO); CEO's for Cities; Urban Land Institute; Fannie Mae; International Council of Shopping Centers; served as Vice-President of the North American International Trade Corridor Partnership (NAITCP); and participated in the Tri-Lateral Technology Summits held between the United States, Canada, and Mexico (2001-2005).

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Records include correspondence, photographs, maps, video and audio tapes that document the administration of Edward Garza as mayor of the City of San Antonio from 2001 through 2005. A majority of the records are administrative files, including Garza's speeches, calendars, travel itineraries, correspondence, and an assortment of articles written about Garza during his term as mayor (15 ft.). The collection also includes committee and subject files on a range of issues, including quality of life, economic development, and international relations (11 ft.), and project files for Garza's city initiatives including San Antonio's emergency preparedness, CitySouth, PGA golf course, MLS soccer, Toyota facility, and Texas A&M at San Antonio (7 ft.).
