CITY SEEKS APPLICANTS FOR NEW BUILDING-RELATED AND FIRE CODES APPEALS AND ADVISORY BOARD

The Building-Related and Fire Codes Appeals and Advisory Board is seeking applicants to fill 34 positions on this newly-created board to hear and decide appeals of orders, decision or determinations made by the Building Official or the Fire Chief relative to the City Code. Citizens interested in applying for a position on the Building-Related and Fire Codes Appeals and Advisory Board may obtain an application at www.sanantonio.gov/clerk. The deadline to submit applications is 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 31, 2012.

Membership will consist of the following categories:

- Structural Engineer, licensed or registered by the State of Texas as a professional engineer.
- Fire Protection Engineer, licensed or registered by the State of Texas as a professional engineer.
- Electrical Engineer, licensed or registered by the State of Texas as a professional engineer.
- Plumbing Engineer or a Mechanical Engineer, licensed or registered by the State of Texas as a professional engineer.

- Architect, licensed by the State of Texas.
- Building Contractor, registered by the City of San Antonio.
- Master Electrician, One individual representing organized labor and one individual representing an open shop, licensed by the State of Texas.
- Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Contractor, One individual representing organized labor and one representing an open shop, licensed by the State of Texas.
- Master Plumber, One representing organized labor and one representing an open shop commercial building contractor, licensed by the State of Texas.
- Commercial building owner, manager, or his/her representative.
- Residential Group R-2 multi-family building owner, manager, or his/her representative.
- Master Sign Electrician, licensed by either the City of San Antonio or the State of Texas.

Meetings are held on the second Wednesday in the months of March, June, September and December at 9 a.m. at the Cliff Morton Development and Business Services Center, 1901 S. Alamo (first floor board room). Meetings last approximately two hours. Special meetings are called during the building-related and fire codes adoption process and whenever formal appeals have been filed.
