Dear Mr. Wright:

The City Staff Development Review Committee has reviewed Belterra Subdivision Master Development Plan M.D.P. # 819. Please find enclosed a signed copy for your files. Your plan was accepted, however please note the following:

- In consideration of public safety and convenience, excessive grades by reason of topography should be avoided in street layouts and arrangements.
- The acceptance of this Master Development Plan # 819 is confined to the boundary limits of the site. Any projection(s) of future roadways outside the boundaries does not infer any set alignment of future roadways. All major arterials and streets shall follow all regulations.
- Any access and R.O.W. issues along state facilities will need to be resolved with the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT). For information about these requirements you can contact TXDOT at 615-5814.
- Plat Certification, the SAWS Aquifer Protection and Evaluation will require the following pursuant to the Aquifer Protection Ordinance No. 81491:

100 year Flood Plain Shown and Buffering (if applicable)

Sensitive Recharge Features and Buffering (if applicable)

Category Letter for All Site Specific Plats (if Category 2 or 3, an Aquifer Protection Plan is required) (if applicable)

Additionally, a Water Pollution Abatement Plan or Contributing Zone Plan must be submitted to and approved by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) prior to construction.

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According to the Water Quality Ordinance #81491, Section 34-913, buffering may be required.

- The Belterra MDP/PUD may be released under the following conditions:
  1. The report includes references to other accepted and approved drainage studies that are acknowledge by Storm Water Engineering. It is understood that at the time of platting a complete drainage study (Storm Water Management Plan) should be submitted and applicable portions of the referenced studies should be included.
  2. Status of the "Indian Springs Development: Elm Waterhole Creek LOMR" is still under review by FEMA, which could affect the easement/property limits of the Belterra development at the time of platting.
- Streets and Drainage approves this project with the following conditions:
  1. The above referenced MDP/PUD is approved with the following conditions:
    - a. Provide typical street section that stipulates pavement width.
    - b. On the Bulverde Road side of the gate detail, move the handicap ramps to the apex.
  2. The following issue should be addressed during the respective platting process: Evaluate potential excessive grades on several streets in Units 1 and 3.
  3. It should be understood that this is a general review of a conceptual plan and that *all* technical requirements of the Unified Development Code for Streets & Drainage shall be complied with.
- This project will be subject to the Streetscape standards and the 2003 Tree Preservation ordinance (Section 35-B125 and Table 35-B101) and is approved.

A Tree Preservation Plan is approved for this MDP using the Tree Stand Delineation Option. A Heritage Tree survey will be submitted with plat applications.

- Bexar County Infrastructures Services Department cites the following conditions:

The Bexar County Infrastructure Services Department has reviewed the Master Development Plan for the Belterra Subdivision located on the southwest corner of Bulverde Road and Smithson Valley Road.

Consisting of 70.019 acres, this development is anticipated to have 203 new residential lots. Two gated access points are proposed along Bulverde Road with the first access point located

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700 feet west of Smithson Valley Road. Future traffic demand may require the first access to be limited to right-in and right-out.

Bexar County currently has plans for full reconstruction of Bulverde Road within the limits of this project. The developer is encouraged to work closely with Bexar County during the design of the Belterra Subdivision.

It is understood that this MDP is a conceptual plan and all regulations will be addressed at time of platting. Bexar County reserves the right to address driveways, street design, sight distance, ADA requirements, drainage and floodplain issues at time of platting.

I would encourage you to work closely with the school district, so that they can plan accordingly.

Please note that this action by the committee does not establish any commitment for the provision of utilities, services or zoning of any type now or in the future by the City of San Antonio. If the proposed development is not platted in phases this Master Development Plan M.D.P. will be invalid.

**ALL Platting shall comply with the Unified Development Code, Master Plan and Major Thoroughfare Plan for the city of San Antonio.**
