**Hurricane Ike Situation Report #10**

- Ike has been downgraded to a tropical storm, moving north at 13 -15 mph. Currently, Tropical Storm Ike is located just southeast of Tyler, Texas with sustained winds of 45mph. It is expected to exit Texas by midnight
- The reception center has processed Reception has processed 5501 individuals through Port San Antonio.
- 4,742 are in general population shelters and 561 are special needs evacuees.
- Currently there are 642 pets being sheltered.
- There are currently 355 personnel from 14 agencies supporting operations at the ARCC.
- The Texas Road Condition and Travel Information line (800-452-9292) is staffed by operators until 8 p.m. CDT on Saturday. Recorded information on road conditions is available on a 24-hour basis. Also, information can be accessed through [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov).
- Metro Health shelter clinics have nursing staff available around the clock. A team of volunteer physicians is assisting at the shelter clinics three times during each day. Most work in the medical clinics is managing chronic conditions and fulfilling short-term needs (i.e. medications, some equipment, etc.)

- The San Antonio Volunteer Organizations Active in Disaster (SAVOAD) is seeking volunteers. Members of the community wishing to help with the response to Hurricane Ike are asked to go to the Coliseum Frontier Room. For more information, contact (210) 224-5365.
