The City of San Antonio's Student Internship Program provides eligible students the opportunity to work in various departments within the City organization. Students are enabled to link theory with practice, gain real-world public sector experience and develop specialized skills that cannot be taught in the classroom.

How to Apply

View available internship opportunities and complete online application at www.sanantonio.gov/hr/jobs.

Eligible applications will be forwarded to the hiring department for consideration, and interviews will be scheduled with selected applicants by the department.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be currently enrolled in an accredited vocational or technical school, college or university (all majors welcome)
- Have completed first year of program of study (preferred)
- Commit to the entire internship session (minimum of 12 weeks)
- Be eligible to work in the United States
- Possess a willingness to learn, positive attitude and self-motivation

Program Details

- Paid and unpaid internships available (maximum 20 hour workweek during semester if paid internship)
- May be eligible for college credit*
- Work locations and schedules vary by department
- Duties vary by department
- Student Interns supported by Intern Mentor and Internship Coordinator
- Starting and ending dates based upon needs of the department

Sample Careers with the City of San Antonio

- *Engineer*: \$72,058 - \$122,499/Bachelor's Degree required; Master's Degree preferred
- *Police Officer/Firefighter*: Salary set by contract/High School Diploma/GED required
- *Helicopter Mechanic*: \$37,535 - \$50,920/hour/High School Diploma/GED and five years of experience
- *City Attorney*: \$92,700 - \$185,400/Juris Doctorate Degree and ten years of experience
- *Information Services Manager*: \$72,058 - \$122,499/Bachelor's Degree required
- *Recreation Specialist*: \$23,046 - \$31,262/hour/High School Diploma or GED required
