# METC



- **Air Force**
  - ***73 total courses***
  - ***Average daily student load = 1667***
  - ***Maximum student load = 2375***
  - ***Note: 13 courses are inter-service***
  
- **Navy**
  - ***29 total courses***
  - ***Average daily student load = 2700***
  - ***Maximum student load = 3032***
  - ***Note: 11 courses are inter-service***
