There are approximately 113 bus stops inside the Eastern Triangle boundary.

Did you know?

There are 161.6 miles of streets, including highways.

There are street rehabilitation projects proposed through 2012 estimated at over \$1,568,500.

There are 2.6 miles of bike trails already in place with 4 additional miles proposed.



There are approximately 16 miles of creeks and intermittent streams throughout the area.

A proposed bridge project estimated at over \$11 million would raise Roland Ave above Salado Creek to prevent future flooding.



All of this is used by almost 25,000 people in an area covering 4,400 acres, not including people from all across the city...

Other things to know:

- There have been 9 traffic humps installed in the past 10 years.**
- The Department of Public Works Adopted Rolling 5 year Infrastructure Management Program has forecasted over \$826,000 for sidewalks in 2009.**
- Eastern Triangle is bisected by 6 major thoroughfares: MLK/Lord Rd, Rigsby Ave, Houston St, Southcross/Roland, Foster Rd, and W.W. White Rd**
