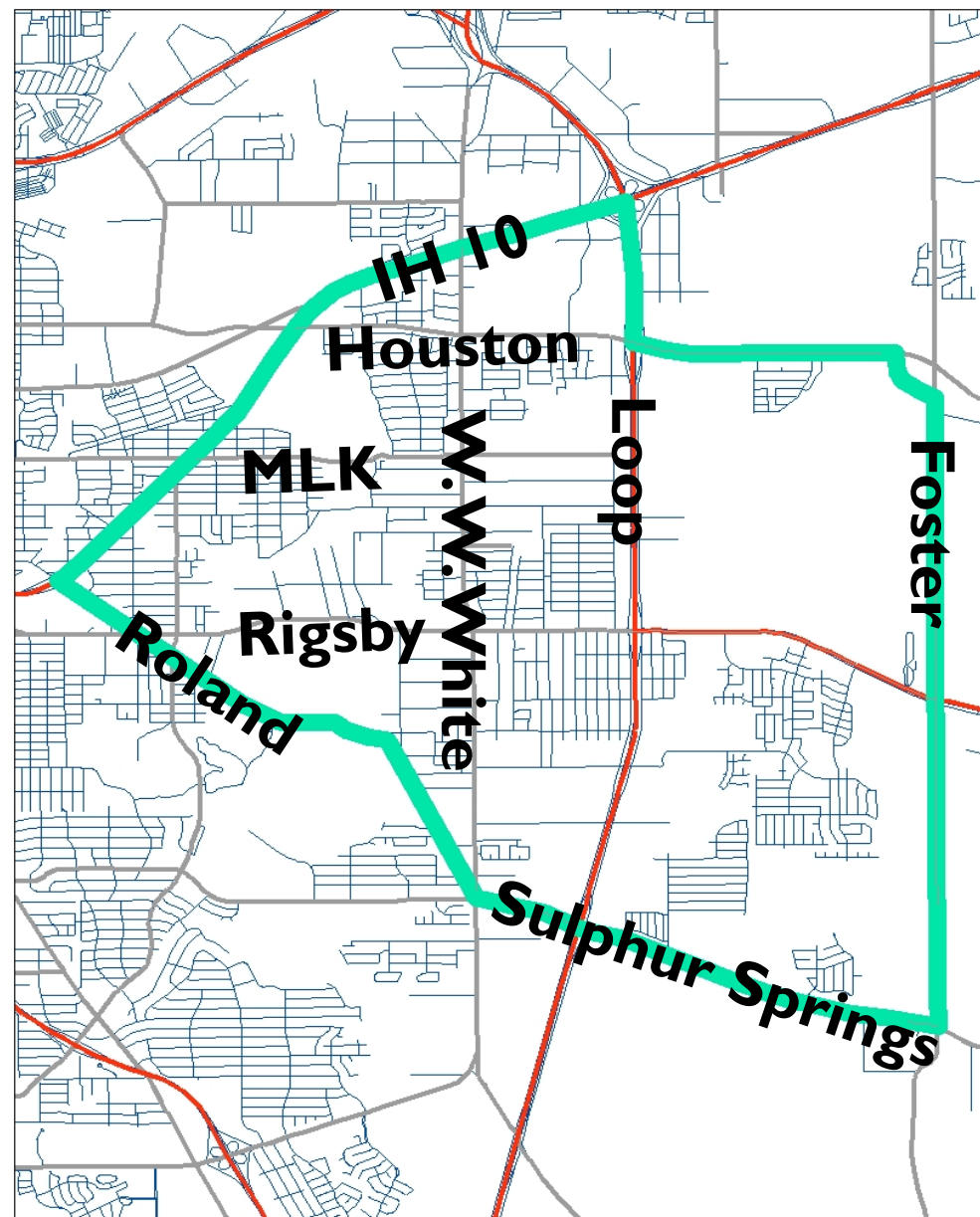
WHAT IS A COMMUNITY PLAN?
