

PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS (P3)

YMCA/Public Library

The YMCA has purchased the former grocery store building at the corner of Potranco & Hwy 151 with the intent to partner with the City to repurpose the former store into a new co-located recreation center and library. Councilman Lopez is also seeking to add multi-purpose athletic fields on a 12-acre parcel adjacent to the proposed YMCA/Public Library building. This project is anticipated to go to City Council for consideration in April, 2015.



Alicia T. Lopez Senior Center Expansion

The Alicia Trevino Lopez Senior Center opened its doors to the newly expanded section on Wednesday, Dec. 17, 2014. The center added 4,200 additional square feet to the current 22,000 square-foot facility. Classrooms, storage rooms, offices, a set of family restrooms, a gaming and recreation area have been added. The expansion re-designed floor space to help meet rising demand for additional activities.



PROJECTS COMPLETED/IN PROGRESS

Marbach Road Phase II B

Design and reconstruct Marbach from Meadow Way to Loop 410 with curbs, sidewalks, driveway approaches, underground drainage and other improvements as needed. This project is a continuation of the 2007 Phase II-A Bond Project and is slated to be completed during 2015.



Tom Slick Park

Improvements included; a new basketball court and a shade structure, pedestrian trail access, site furniture, and signage. It was completed in 2014.



Shaenfield Road

Roadway extension from Loop 1604 to Terra Oaks cul-de-sac (11' travel lanes, 5' bike lanes, 12' left turn lanes and 6' sidewalks) and a bridge to span Helotes Creek. A developer will build the roadway from the bridge over Helotes Creek to Loop 1604.



Westwood Village Drainage Phase II

Construct a detention basin west of Pinn Rd. adjacent to Westwood Village Creek. This project is a continuation of Phase I from the 2007 Bond Program. Slated to be finished in Spring 2015.



Hunt Lane

Reconstruct and widen Hunt Ln. from Ingram to Potranco to four lanes with concrete medians, sidewalks, curbs, driveway approaches, a shared use path, and drainage and traffic signal improvements. Construct Heritage Farms St. to connect Sawtooth St. to Hunt Ln.
* Completed in April, 2014



Leon Creek Greenway - Ingram to Military Dr.

Design and construction of hike and bike trails along the Leon Creek area including all associated trailheads and amenities for a stretch of creek approximately 2.2 miles in length.



Culebra Creek Greenway (A)



Design and construction of hike and bike trails along the Culebra Creek area from Shaenfield Road to Culebra Creek Park. Multi-use trail is approximately; 1.6 miles in length & includes one trailhead, signage and associated amenities.

Culebra Creek Greenway (B)

Design and construction of hike and bike trails along the Culebra Creek area from Cathedral Rock Park to Grissom Road. Multi-use trail is approximately



1.2 miles in length. Project includes one trailhead, signage and associated amenities.

UPCOMING PROJECTS - INFRASTRUCTURE

Old Grissom Road

Provide a bicycle underpass through a concrete structure under Old Grissom Road. Mill and overlay roadway from Culebra to Grissom Road.



Ingram Road - Mabe to Culebra

Reconstruct and widen Ingram to a four-lane roadway with bicycle facilities. Curbs, sidewalks, driveway approaches, traffic and drainage improvements will be added as needed.




Tezel Road - Culebra/Grissom to Timber Path



Tezel will be widened to four lanes with curbs, bike lanes and a continuous two-way left-turn lane north of Camino Rosa. Construct drainage improvements and add or replace sidewalks as needed.

Mountain View Estates Phase III Drainage

Install drainage system that ties into an existing box culvert system on Rogers and outfalls into a tributary of Culebra Creek to resolve flooding issues in the Mountain View Estates area. Project will complement Phases I and II completed previously.



UPCOMING PROJECTS - PARKS

Acme, Cuellar & Levis Straus Parks - Group 1

Each of the parks will receive new concrete walkways, shade structures, fencing and added parking. Other improvements will include, a new rubber resurfaced trail at Acme Park, a new picnic table, barbeque pit and trash receptacle at Cuellar Park and a new concrete half basketball court at Levi Strauss Park.

General park improvements including parking, trails, lighting and playground expansions.



Oscar Perez & New Territories Parks - Group 2

Each of these parks will receive improvements to the existing trails, site furniture, & security lighting. New Territories will receive a new shade structure, a new picnic area, & additional area lighting. Oscar Perez will relocate the baseball field to accommodate expansion of the existing parking lot & will receive enhanced trail markers.
