Title	2015 IECC Transition from the 2009 IECC
Description	<p>This 6-hour seminar will assist participants in implementing the transition from the 2009 <i>International Energy Conservation Code</i>[®] (IECC[®]) to the 2015 edition. It will include relevant changes that first appeared in the 2012 IECC as well as those changes new to the 2015 edition. This training will focus on the key changes and their effects on design, review and inspection requirements. Small group activities and knowledge review questions will provide ample opportunity for participants to discuss and consider the changes. It is expected that seminar participants are already familiar with the 2009 IECC and its application.</p>
