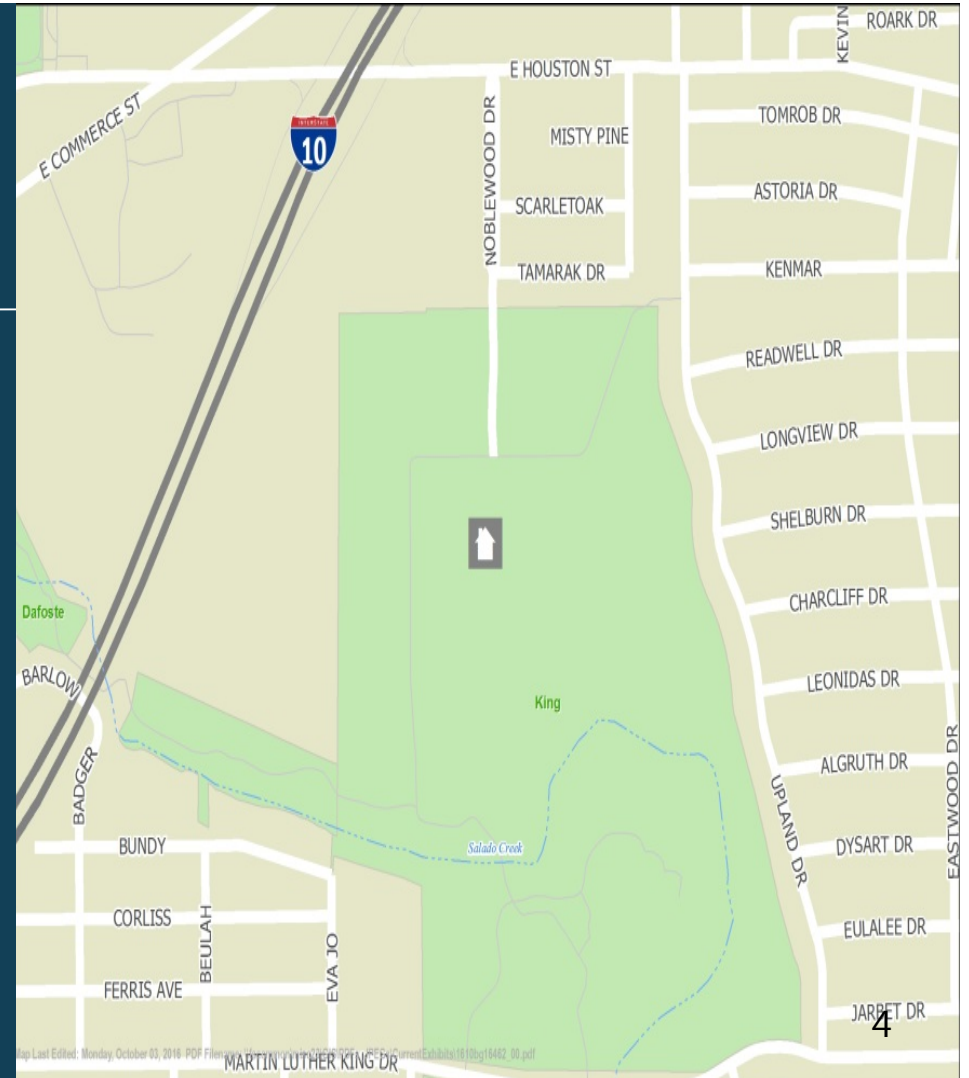
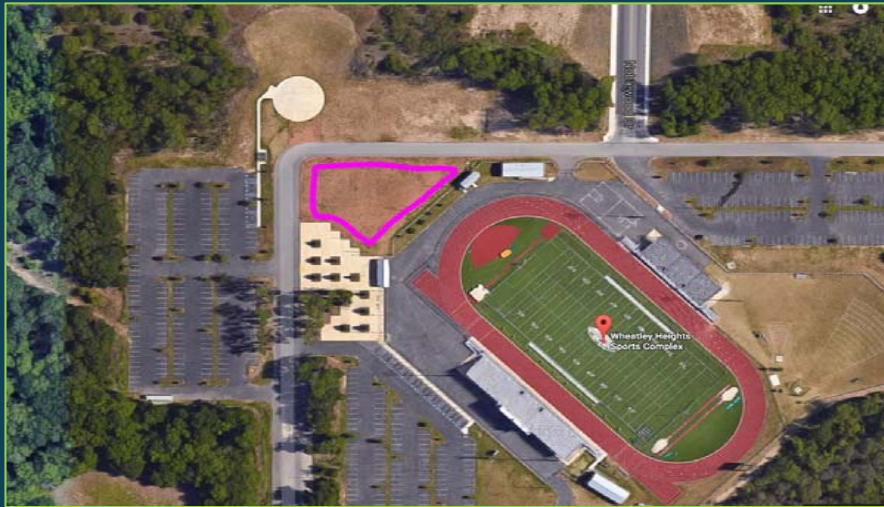

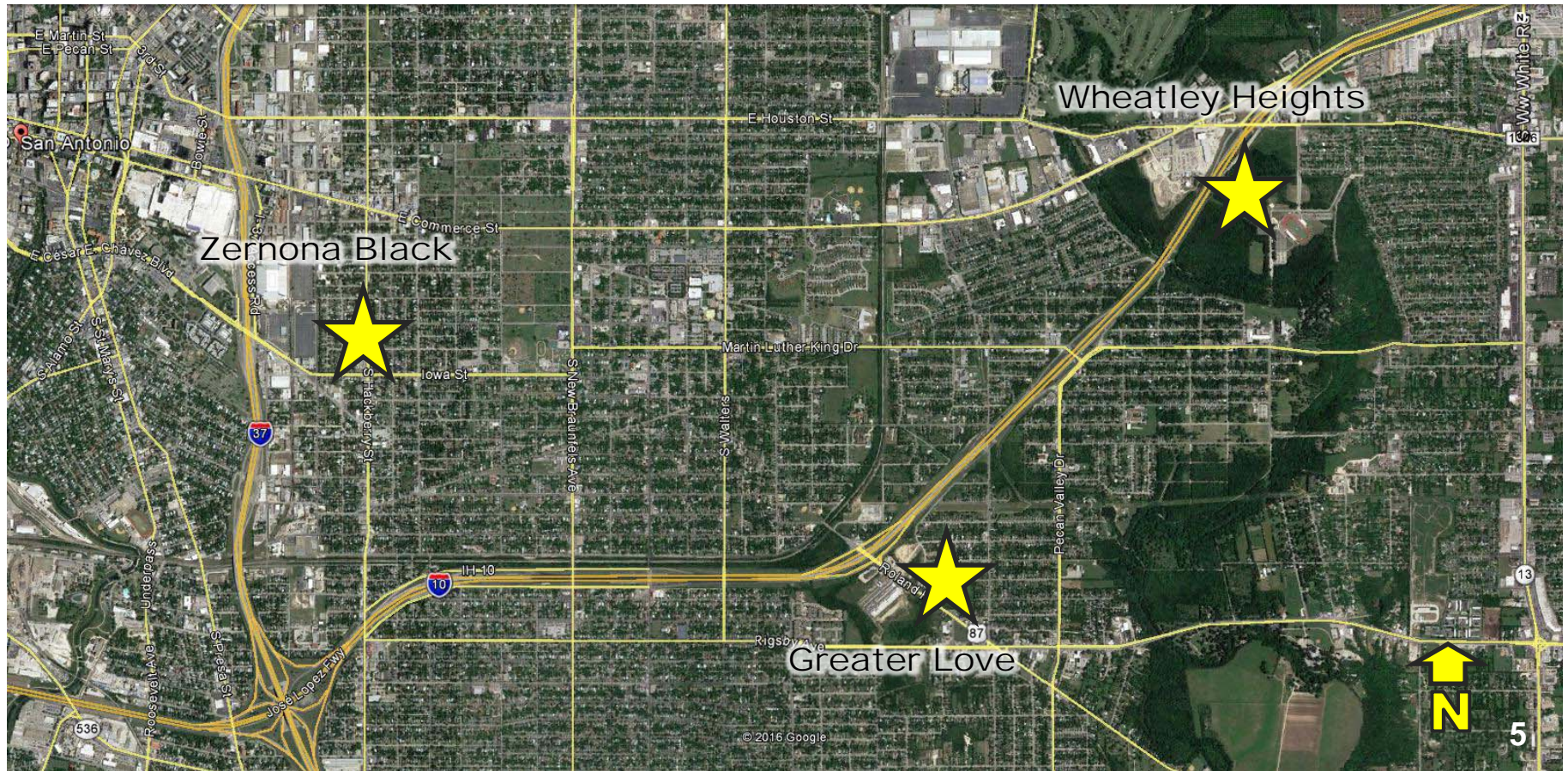
# Wheatley Heights Community Center \$6 Million

# District 2 Community Centers Area Map



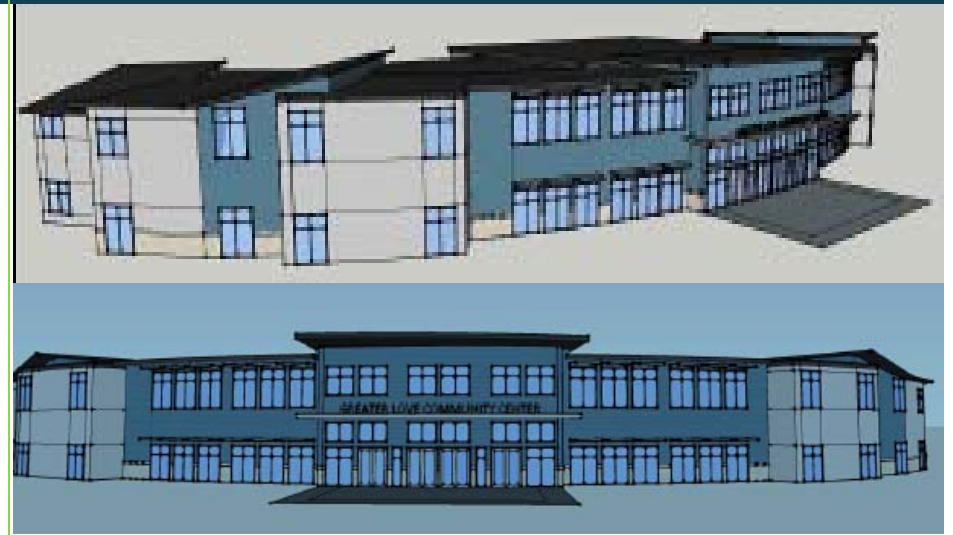
## Zernona Black Community Center

**Services Provided:** State-funded Pre-K for 3 to 5 year olds (50 to 100 kids); parenting classes to include financial literacy and job training; after-school programs, health care services, senior daycare and leased space.

| Wheatley Heights | Original scope to include staff parking, men's and women's showers and locker rooms, meeting spaces, large activity space, administrative offices, restrooms, first aid, referee/officials meeting room, and kitchen area. | \$3,000,000 | Reduce scope from \$6M to \$3M to construct parking, locker rooms, first aid, and referee/officials meeting room. Split remaining \$3M for two proposed community centers. |
| Zernona Black    | Classrooms, offices, computer lab, other amenities, parking.   | \$1,500,000 | Funds provided from Wheatley Heights decrease.   |
| Greater Love     | Classrooms, offices, computer lab, meeting space, other amenities, parking.  | \$1,500,000 | Funds provided from Wheatley Heights decrease.   |
