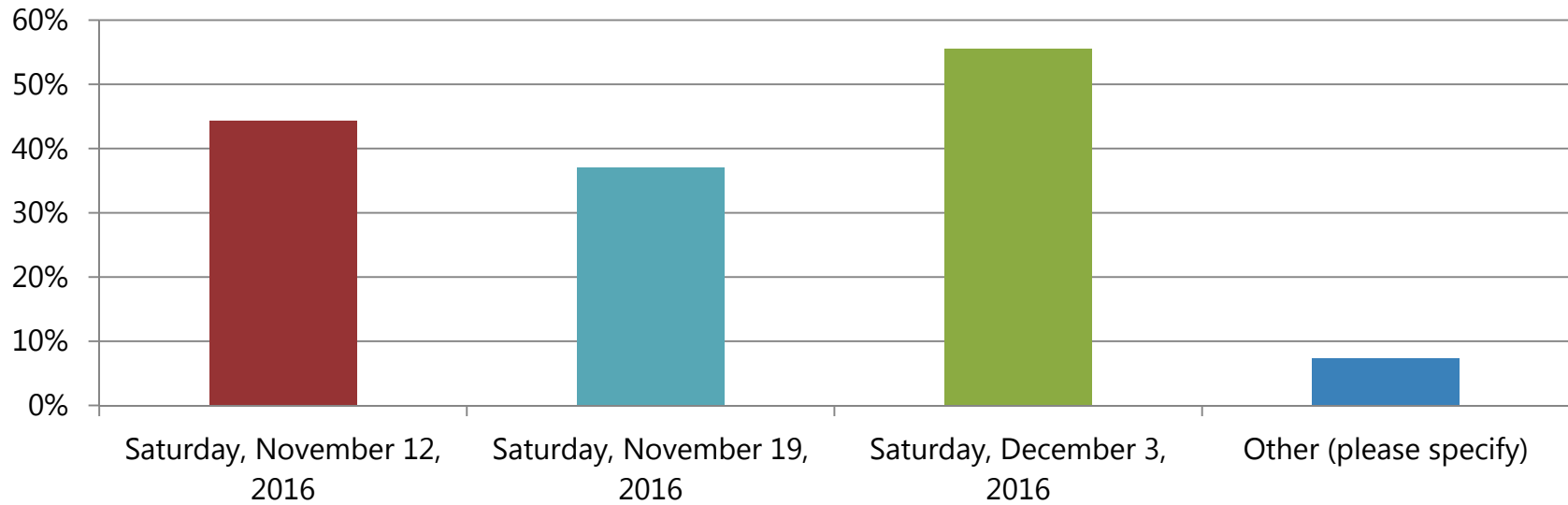

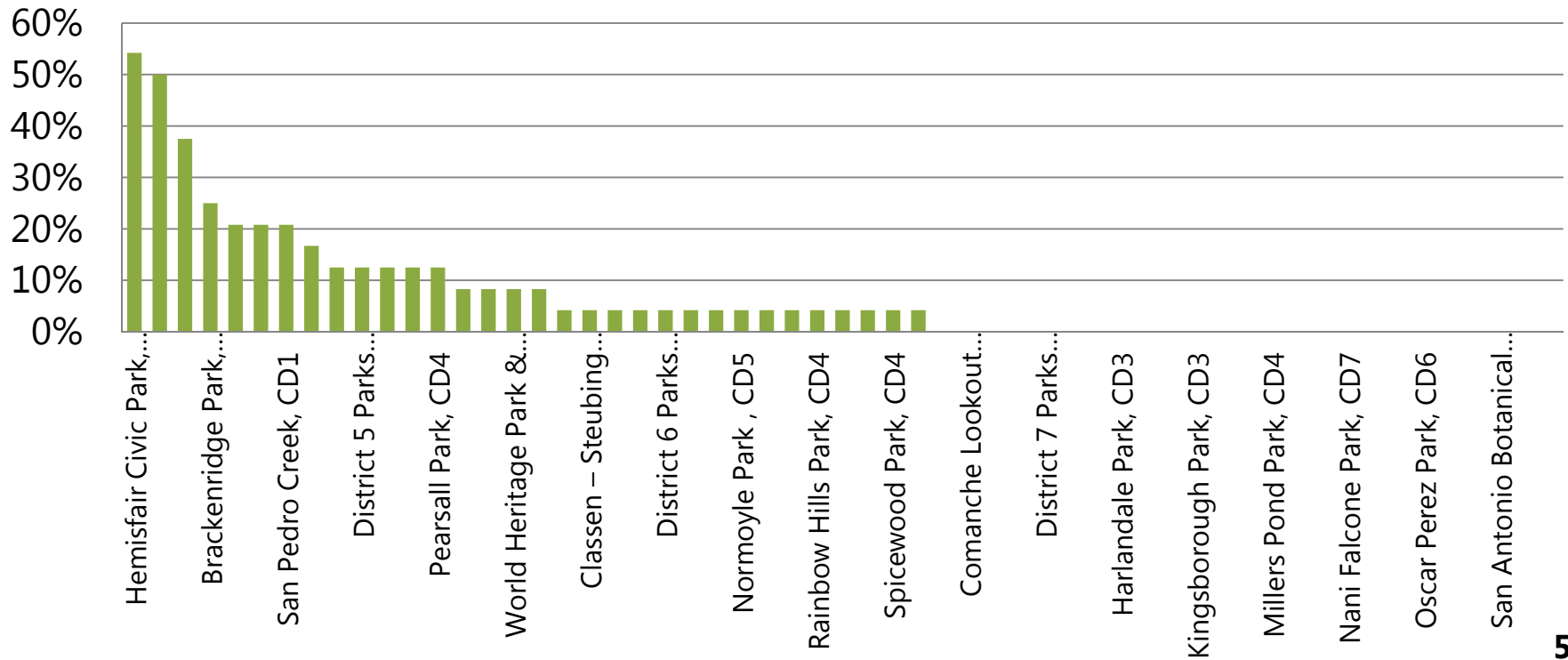
**Survey Question (1) :** Select one of the dates on which you would like to take a tour.

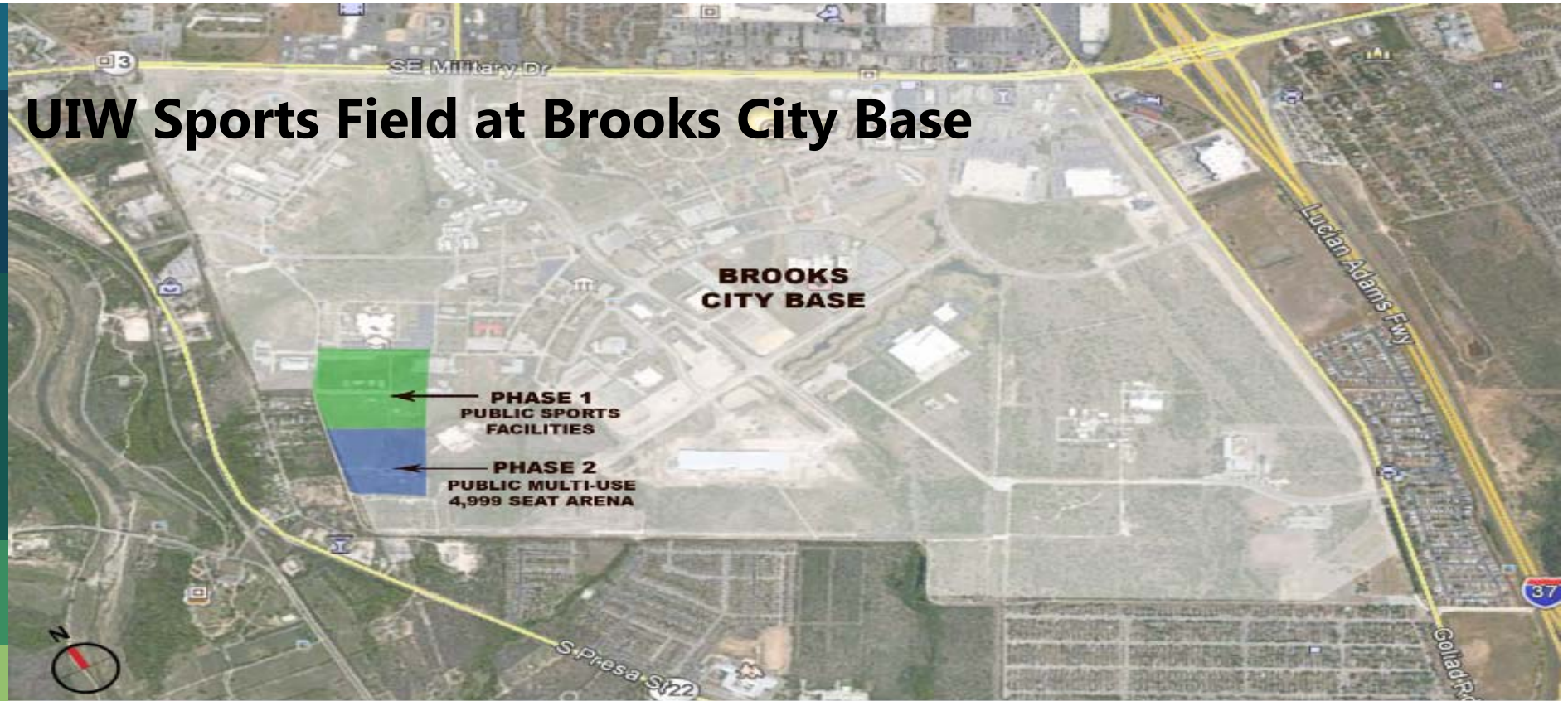

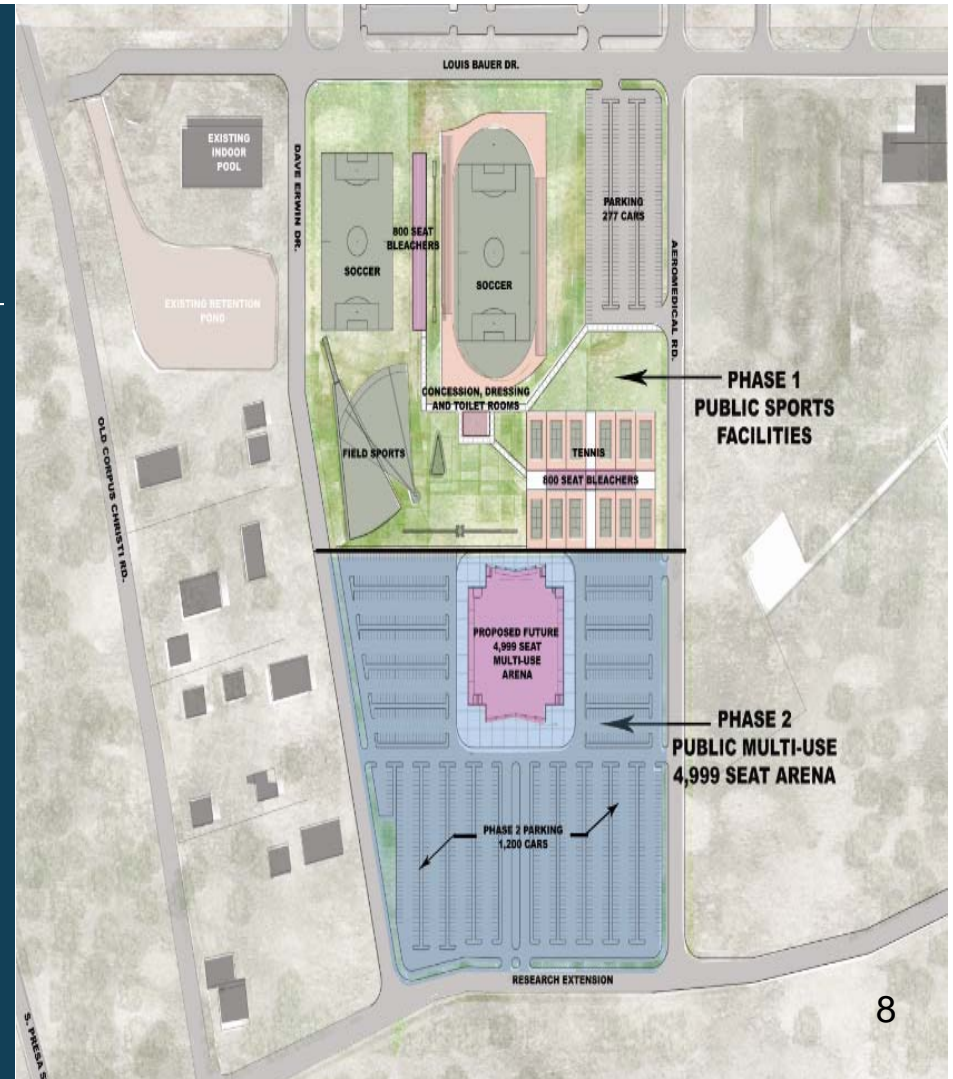
