Seeing Stray Cats?

Community cats are the un-owned stray or feral cats who live outdoors in our neighborhoods. They can be humanely trapped by citizens and ACS will sterilize and ear tip them (universal symbol for TNR). They can then be safely returned to the community 24 hours after surgery.

To become part of the Community Cat Program you will need to come to ACS during these hours to get signed up, get vouchers for surgery, and traps (if available).

Cats must meet the following criteria to be eligible for TNR:

- The cat lives strictly outside
 - The cat has no owner (No collar, tags and/or microchip)
 - The cat appears to be healthy and is of healthy weight
 - The cat is at least 2lbs and roughly at least 10 weeks of age
 - All cats must be in humane cat traps
 - All cats must be returned to their original colony after 24-hour recovery. (Dumping cats is illegal).
