Subject: Soil relocation from the Ray Ellison Project

Dear Property Owner/Current Resident:

The purpose of this letter is to provide property owners/residents information regarding the soil being relocated from the Ray Ellison project to an alternative location during construction.

The City Soil Policy provides guidelines that the Transportation & Capital Improvements (TCI) department follows when a significant amount of soil is being hauled due to construction activities associated with street, drainage, park and building projects. Prior to any excavation, the soil is tested by private, licensed environmental consulting professionals and is compared to Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) standards for appropriate reuse or disposition.

Based on the results of the testing for the Ray Ellison project, the soil meets residential standards for re-use, as established by the TCEQ. The soil can safely be used on residential or commercial properties. Therefore, the soil will be relocated to 11954 Pearsall Road, Atascosa, Texas 78002.
