**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN THE MUNICIPAL PLAZA BUILDING "B" ROOM,
MONDAY, MAY 17, 2005**

The City Council convened in a Special City Council Meeting in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Plaza Building.

The Meeting was called to order at 2:00 P.M. by the Presiding Officer, Mayor Edward D. Garza, with the following members present: Flores, Perez, Radle, Barrera, Haass, Garza. **ABSENT:** Williams, Segovia, Castro, Hall, Schubert.

Ms. Leticia M. Vacek, City Clerk narrated a powerpoint presentation on the City of San Antonio Canvassing Report of the May 7, 2005 Joint General and Special Election, a copy of which is on file with the Office of the City Clerk. Ms. Vacek outlined the procedures, under and over votes, late mail ballots/provisional ballots, and the votes cast vs. number of registered voters. She then provided the City Council Election Results by district and for Mayor, and Propositions 1, 2, and 3. Ms. Vacek clarified the vote tabulation, recommendations, run-off election information and contract, and what the next steps would be.

The City Clerk read the following ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE 100876

CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF THE JOINT GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2005; ORDERING A RUN-OFF ELECTION FOR THE CITY COUNCIL TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 7, 2005; AND ESTABLISHING EARLY VOTING AND ELECTION DAY POLLING LOCATIONS FOR THE RUN-OFF ELECTION.

Councilmember Perez made a motion to approve the proposed Ordinance. Councilmember Radle seconded the motion.

After consideration, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Ordinance, prevailed by the following vote: **AYES:** Flores, Perez, Radle, Barrera, Haass, Garza. **NAYS:** None. **ABSENT:** Williams, Segovia, Castro, Hall, Schubert.

Ms. Leticia M. Vacek, City Clerk administered the Statements of Elected Officer. The Oaths of Office were then administered to the successful candidates by Ms. Vacek and County Judge Nelson Wolff.

Mayor Garza issued Certificates of Election to the successful candidates.

Mayor Garza recessed the Special Session at 2:46 pm in order to convene in Executive Session for the purpose of:

Discuss the Election Lawsuit, Cynthia Test, Contestant vs. Noel Suniga, Contestee pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.071 (consultation with attorney).

Mayor Garza reconvened the Special Session from Executive Session at 3:00 pm, at which time he stated City Council had been briefed on the above-styled matters and gave staff direction, but had taken no official action.

The "B" Session adjourned at 3:01pm.
