**A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WAS HELD IN THE MUNICIPAL PLAZA BUILDING, FRIDAY JUNE 17, 2005.**

The City Council convened in a Special City Council Meeting in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Plaza Building.

The Meeting was called to order at 2:00 P.M. by the Presiding Officer, Mayor Edward D. Garza, with the following members present: Flores, McNeil, Gutierrez, Perez, Radle, Barrera, Haass, Garza. **ABSENT:** Castro, Hall, Wolff.

Ms. Leticia Vacek, City Clerk, made a presentation on the election returns for the June 7, 2005 Run-off Election. She outlined the procedures, under votes, over votes, manual adjustment count for the late mail-in ballots and provisional ballots. She further elaborated on the votes cast vs. number of registered voters in two precincts, one for Early Voting and the second for Election Day. She then delineated the votes for the respective candidates for Districts 6 and 7, and for the Mayor's race, noting that the total number of votes cast was 130,201 which represented 18.88% of the registered voters in San Antonio.


There being no further business to come before the City Council, Mayor Garza adjourned the meeting at 3:00 pm.
