SAN ANTONIO (May 14, 2015) – The City of San Antonio is currently accepting applications from qualified individuals who are eligible to serve on the San Antonio Bike Share Board of Directors. The Board of Directors will be comprised of 9 members, three (3) of which will be appointed by the Mayor and City Council.

San Antonio Bike Share, a 501c3 non-profit organization, is responsible for bringing bike share services to the San Antonio region in close partnership with the City of San Antonio. San Antonio's public bike share program, San Antonio B-Cycle, launched in March of 2011 with 14 stations and 140 bikes, and has since grown to 55 stations and 450 bikes.
