



## Q5 Rate your overall comfort level when thinking of a general emergency or disaster







## Q7 What steps have you taken to prepare for an emergency that might occur in our community?





### Q13 If an emergency or natural disaster impacted San Antonio knocking out electricity and running water, would your household be able to manage on its own for at least three days?





## Q15 Overall, how would you rate the difficulty of evacuating your home?










