


# Eastside Promise Neighborhood

August 2015

The Eastside Promise Neighborhood (EPN), in partnership with its public, private and civic partners, is building an integrated, comprehensive pathway that supports the success of every child from birth to college to career.

EPN has just completed its third full year of implementation.

The EPN continuum of solutions, which feature cradle-to-career educational reforms and targeted community supports, is yielding significant gains on both the micro (individual children and families) and macro (neighborhood/system) levels.
