




Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Girls Empowerment Summit?

The Girls Empowerment Summit is a free 2 day event on March 13-14 for girls aged 14-18 years old that will tap into skill building opportunities and focuses on positive body image, self-care, social media awareness, and non-traditional career roles for women. The second day of the summit will be in partnership with the San Antonio Fire Department providing girls with the opportunity to participate in *Camp Hero Like Her* which educates and inspires young girls to consider a career in firefighting. Where is the Girls Empowerment Summit held on March 13?

On March 13, the Girls Empowerment Summit will be held at Palo Alto College, Performing Arts Center. The address for Palo Alto College is 1400 W Villaret Blvd, San Antonio, Texas 78224.



When does the Girls Empowerment Summit begin on March 13?

Doors open at 8 a.m. at Palo Alto College. Breakfast and registration will take place between 8 a.m. – 9 a.m. Summit events will begin at 9 a.m.

When does the Girls Empowerment Summit end on March 13?

Summit activities end at 4:30 p.m. on March 13. Staff will be onsite until 5:30 p.m. for pick-up.

When can I pick-up my child from the Girls Empowerment Summit on March 13?



Where is the Girls Empowerment Summit held on March 14?

On March 14, the Girls Empowerment Summit will be hosted in partnership with the San Antonio Fire Department's *Camp Hero Like Her* at the Fire Training Academy. The address for the Fire Training Academy is 300 S. Callaghan, San Antonio, Texas 78227.



When does Camp Hero Like Her begin on March 14?

Registration begins and doors open at 9 a.m. at the Fire Training Academy. The camp activities will begin at 9:30 a.m.

When does Camp Hero Like Her end on March 14?

Camp activities end at 4 p.m. on March 14. Staff will be onsite until 5 p.m. for pick-up.

When can I pick-up my child from Camp Hero Like Her on March 14?

You can pick-up your child anytime throughout the day on March 14. Official camp activities will conclude at 4 p.m. and staff will be on-site until 5 p.m. for pick-up

What is the dress attire for March 14?

Athletic clothing and walking/tennis shoes are required.

Is the Girls Empowerment Summit an overnight camp?

No, the summit is a 2 day event with each day beginning in the morning and ending in the afternoon each day.


What is the age range for eligibility?


My daughter needs transportation. Will transportation be provided?

Yes, transportation options will be provided at the following locations:



When can I drop-off my child at the transportation location?

Participants can be dropped off as early as 8 a.m. and no later than 8:30 a.m.

When can I pick-up my child at the transportation location?

On March 13, participants will begin loading buses at 4:30 p.m. at Palo Alto College. Buses are anticipated to arrive at the transportation locations no later than 5:30 p.m. Staff will remain on-site at the transportation location until 6 p.m. for pick-up.

On March 14, participants will begin loading buses at 4 p.m. at the Fire Training Academy. Buses are anticipated to arrive at the transportation locations no later than 4:45 p.m. Staff will remain on-site at the transportation location until 5 p.m. for pick-up.

How was the transportation locations identified?

Locations were selected based on needs identified through the registration process.
