ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

The purpose of the Council Committees is to review items for recommendation to forward to the full City Council for consideration. Since 2004, the Office of the City Clerk has drafted and maintained the meeting minutes of the City Council Committees. Prior to 2004, the minutes were maintained by Executive Assistants responsible for coordinating each Committee and/or whom report to the Office of the City Manager.

The Mayor creates the Committees and appoints Councilmembers each election cycle. There are typically four or five City Councilmembers on each Committee, one of whom is designated by the Mayor as the Chair. Additionally, each Committee is supported by a Lead (often an Assistant City Manager) and an Executive Assistant. Each Committee meets approximately once per month. Through time some of the names of the Committees, as well as their areas of focus, change. The Mayor makes these changes to reflect the changing needs of the City of San Antonio.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The City Council Committee Minutes collection contains six volumes (2,252 pages) of typed meeting minutes of several City of San Antonio City Council Committees, dating from 2004 to 2014. New meeting minutes are added to the collection as they become available. In the Committee Meetings, City Councilmembers discuss issues pertinent to the citizens of the City of San Antonio and the development of policies for the City. They also provide oversight to the Boards and Commissions that are assigned to each committee. There are eleven City Council Committees listed herein, ten of which are currently in operation.

The **Internal Audit** Committee is responsible for internal audit and financial management. The **Economic and Community Development** Committee is responsible for policies related to economic development, BRAC, military affairs, international affairs, workforce and education, aviation, tourism, and community redevelopment. The **Educational Excellence** Committee is responsible for working with school districts in San Antonio and focuses on initiatives such as Head Start, Pre-K 4 SA, literacy, and scholarships. The **Governance** Committee oversees new initiatives for policy and development, the municipal court, and intergovernmental relations. The **High Profile Contracts** Committee oversees major contracts related to facilities and departments such as the Convention Center, the Alamodome, and Transportation and Capital Improvements. The **Infrastructure and Growth** Committee is responsible for policies related to transportation, roads and sidewalks, infrastructure, VIA Metropolitan Transit, environmental quality, water delivery and SAWS, CPS Energy, and development codes. The **Intergovernmental Relations** Committee oversees policies related to federal, state, and local agencies, proposed legislation, representation contracts, and grant opportunities. The **Public Safety** Committee oversees policies related to the Police Department, Fire Department, emergency operations, law enforcement, and homeland security. The **Quality of Life** Committee oversees policies related to parks, animal care, homeless services, neighborhoods, code compliance, health, library, solid waste programs, affordable housing, and community initiative programs. The **San Antonio/Bexar County Joint Committee on Truancy** worked to develop a uniform truancy policy that incorporates considerations of intervention, the process for court proceedings, and data collection at the school level. The **Urban Affairs** Committee focused on land use, housing and neighborhood projects, and amendments to the Unified Development Code.
