


UNDERSTANDING YOUR

PROPERTY TAXES

2015

The San Antonio real estate market is undergoing unprecedented growth and value increases. The good news is that your most valuable asset "your home" is probably more valuable.

A secondary result can be higher property tax appraisals. If you believe your appraised value is too high, you can appeal it to the Bexar Appraisal District by June 1. Appeals can be filed by mail, fax or, oftentimes, on-line.



Value increases can be mitigated by some limitations. They include a 10% per year value increase cap on homestead properties, a freeze on the taxes of persons who are over 65 years old, disabled veterans exemptions, and disabled individuals exemptions.
