

San Antonio Bikes Updates

A number of initiatives are underway to support alternative transportation through cycling in our city. Here are a few of the highlights:

- Funding has been secured to expand the municipal bike share system in the downtown core and complete the Mission Reach Expansion
- San Antonio continues to share best practices with other cities looking into bike sharing
- 2012 Bond projects will have a good showing of improved and safe accommodations for bicycles and pedestrians
- With state-of-the-art equipment, staff is working with Public Works to establish baseline usage numbers to determine the impact new facilities have on cycling and pedestrian activity on roadways and Greenway trails.
- New print and online maps are being developed



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- Events, such as Park(ing) Day, Siclovia, the Mission Reach Grand Opening, and the Walk & Roll Corporate Challenge are celebrating our community's commitment to promoting active transportation for personal and environmental health
- Bike lights, helmets, water bottles and sunscreen are being handed out at fall community events and we are partnering with SAPD to communicate the importance of bicycle safety, sharing the road, and obeying traffic laws
