The stations now extend south of downtown, from Roosevelt Park to Mission San José.

On Friday, after a blessing of the bikes, Mayor Julián Castro said the new stations offer people a new way to appreciate the beauty of the missions and the river.

Anyone can sign up for B-Cycle, which was launched last year. Users can buy annual, weekly or daily memberships and use any bike from any station for short trips. The bikes have to be reset at a station within 30 minutes to avoid extra charges.
