Traffic Calming Request Application

All traffic calming requests should be submitted through the City of San Antonio's Traffic Calming Request Application. The application can be found at the following web address:

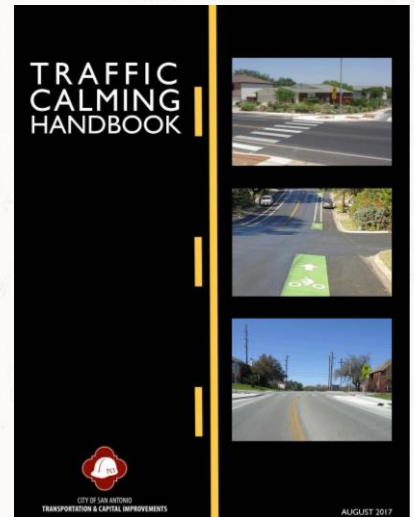

The City's Transportation & Capital Improvements Department (TCI) will send the applicant notification of application receipt and study findings by mail. Inquiry into the status can be done by phone at any time, but please note the evaluation process may take a few months. Traffic data collection and surveys are conducted during normal traffic conditions which excludes summer and holiday breaks.

Speed Hump Criteria

When TCI receives a speed hump request for traffic calming, the following criteria must be fulfilled for consideration:

- **LENGTH:** The roadway must be at least 1/4 mile (1,320 feet) in length.
- **VOLUME:** 24-hour traffic counts must exceed 500 vehicles per day.
- **SPEED:** The average speed of motorists must exceed 35 miles per hour.
- **SIGNATURES:** Property owners representing 2/3 of the properties along the study length must sign the Traffic Calming Request Application in support.
