(Union Pacific Railroad Bridge at S. St. Mary’s Street to Loop 410)**

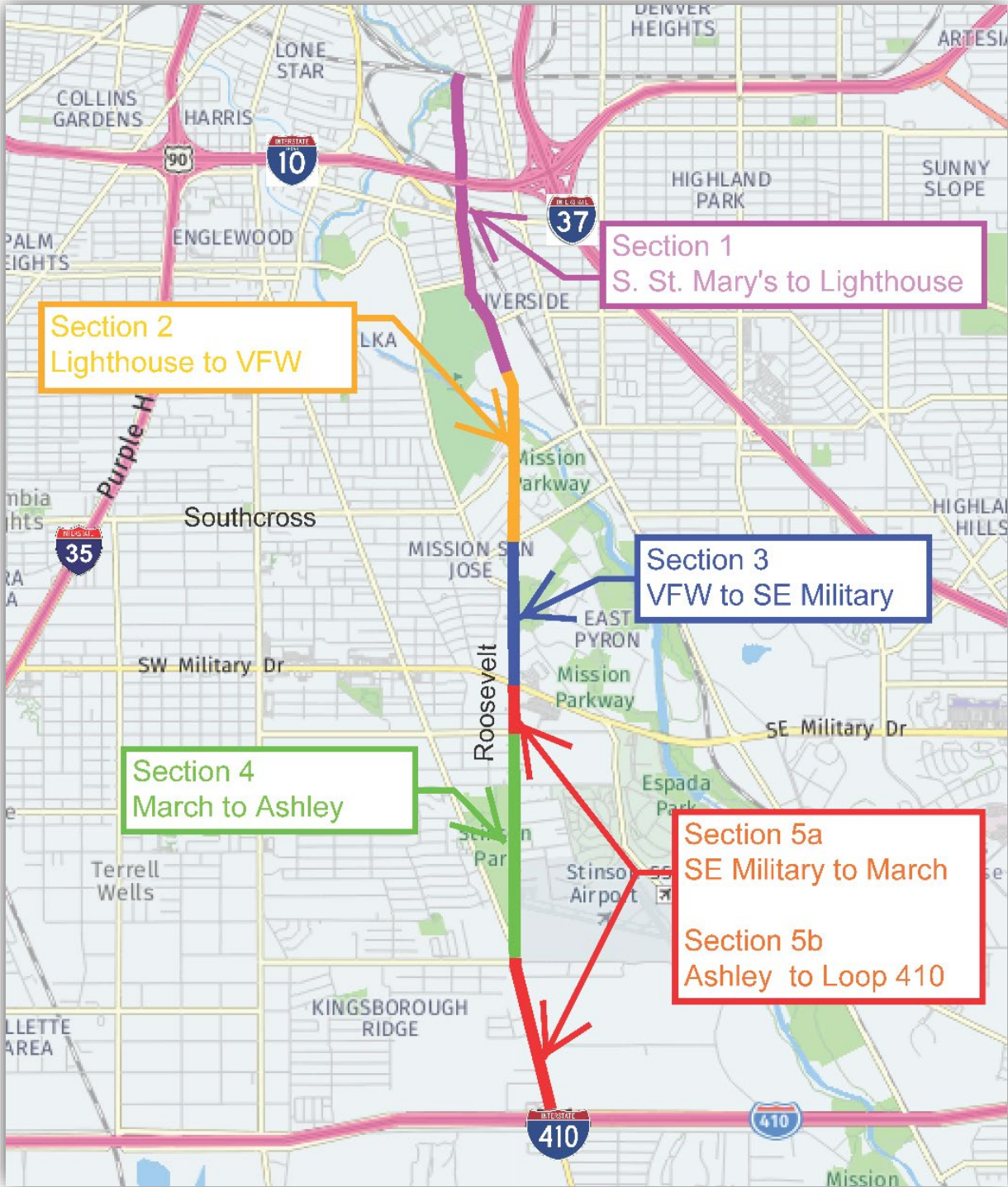
Roosevelt Avenue - Project Overview

Of the \$25 million for improving key corridor streets, there is a combined \$13 million investment for Roosevelt Avenue in the 2017-2022 Bond Program. The City will also receive \$5.6 million in federal funding for a total project amount of \$18.6 million.

Since early 2019, the City has engaged an open, public input process with the residents to create an overall vision and master plan for Roosevelt Avenue. This plan will include corridor improvements and pedestrian amenities along 5.6 miles from the historic railroad bridge at S. St. Mary’s St. to Loop 410. Other corridor enhancements will include bicycle facilities, sidewalks, landscaping, and ADA access under the Union Pacific Railroad bridge.

Due to the length and right-of-way along Roosevelt Avenue, the project was divided into 5 sections:

- Section 1: South St. Mary’s St. to San Antonio Lighthouse for the Blind
- Section 2: San Antonio Lighthouse for the Blind to VFW Blvd.
- Section 3: VFW Blvd. to S.E. Military Dr.
- Section 4: March Ave. to Ashley Rd.
- Section 5A: S.E. Military Dr. to March Ave.
- Section 5B: Ashley Rd. to Loop 410
