- **Will residents who live on Napier Ave. be notified about possible name change? My husband and I do not wish to have our street name changed.**

- **When is the Open House (referring to World Heritage Facility)?**

Public Discussions on the World Heritage Facility are in the preliminary stages. A survey will be available on the World Heritage Office website. Share with your neighbors and complete the survey to provide feedback.

- **The possible site for public art is at Huff and Mission Road?**

Yes, the possible location is the triangle green area at Mission and Huff. The Department of Arts & Culture will do more extensive community engagement later this summer.
