Food Manager/Handler Training Options

Metro Health requires that each business that serves open, potentially hazardous foods and drinks have one Certified Food Manager on duty at all times during hours of operation. To meet this standard, please follow the steps listed below.

- 1) Take and pass the [Certified Food Manager](#) through [360 Training.com](#) and download your certificate online.
OR
- 2) Take and pass a Texas Department of State Health Services approved Food Manager Training Course or approved Test. (see list below)
- 3) Receive the Texas Department of State Health Services certificate.
- 4) Bring that certificate to the Metro Health counter at the **Cliff Morton Development and Business Services Center** located at 1901 S. Alamo St. to obtain your Metro Health ID Card.
