

Bexar County Population Estimates, 2013-2017




**Quick Facts**

- Bexar County houses the city of San Antonio, the 7th largest city by population in the United States




Bexar County Age Breakdown, 2017

Bexar County Population Breakdown Compared to Texas, 2017




The median age is 33.5 years.

Education Attainment for Adults (25 and older) in Bexar County, 2017




In Bexar County about 59% of the residents have obtained a higher education outside of high school.

### Transportation


92.5% of households have access to at least one vehicle.

Bexar County Household Income Compared to Texas, 2017







Percent of Uninsured People in Bexar County Compared to Texas, 2013-2017




In 2017, it was reported that about **15%** of the residents in Bexar County **did not have insurance**.

Percent of Uninsured People in Bexar County By Age Group, 2017




The adult population (19-64 years) has the largest proportion of people uninsured.

Year Structure was Built for Occupied Housing Units in Bexar County, 2017




Homes built prior to 1978 are potentially filled with lead based paint. Lead paint can cause damage to the brain and other vital organs. Lead may also be responsible for learning disabilities and behavioral problems in children. In Bexar County almost 42% of occupied home structures were built before 1980. (US Department of Housing and Urban Development)


Percent of Income Spent on Housing in Bexar County Compared to Texas, 2017

in Bexar County by Race, 2017




Almost 1 in 4 Hispanic adults hold less than a high school education. Compared to 1 in 2 Asian adults hold a Bachelor's Degree or Higher.
