

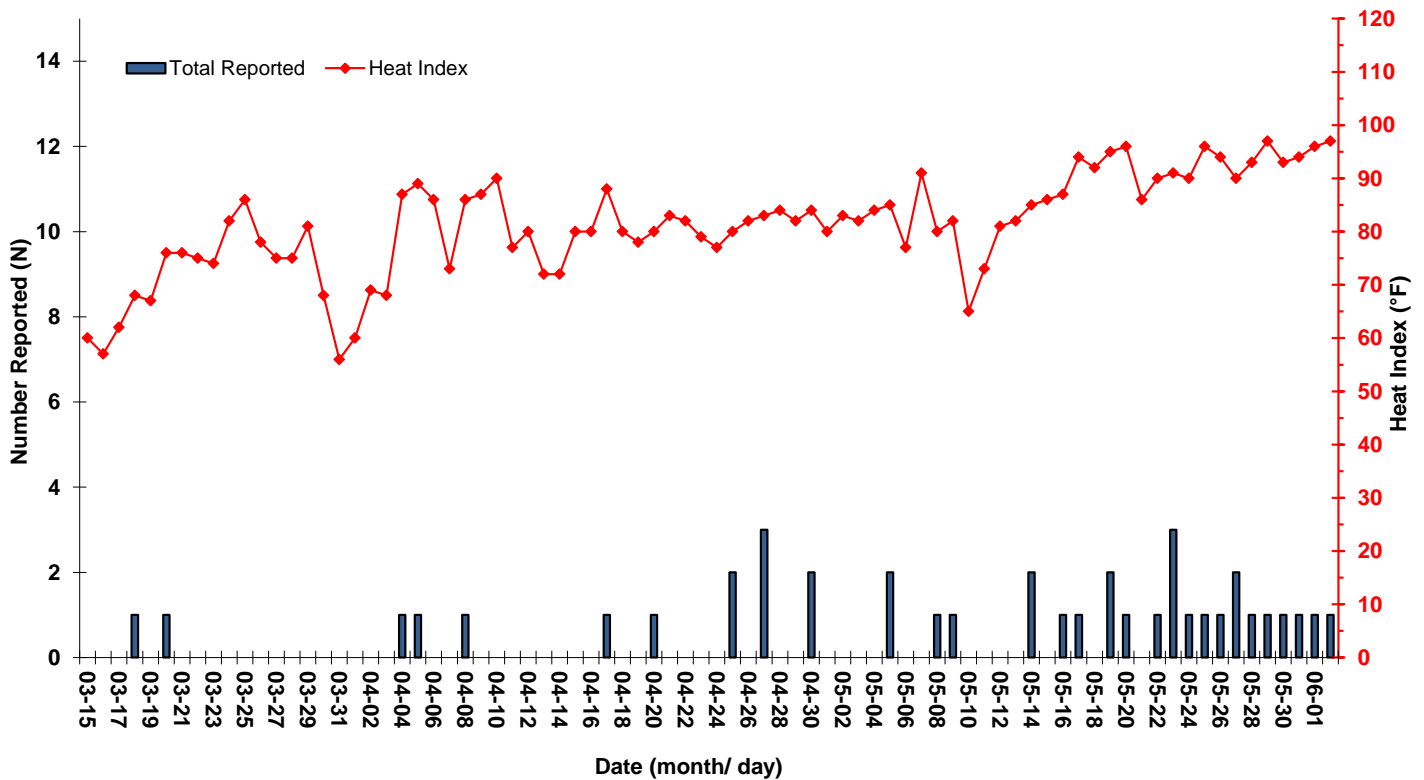

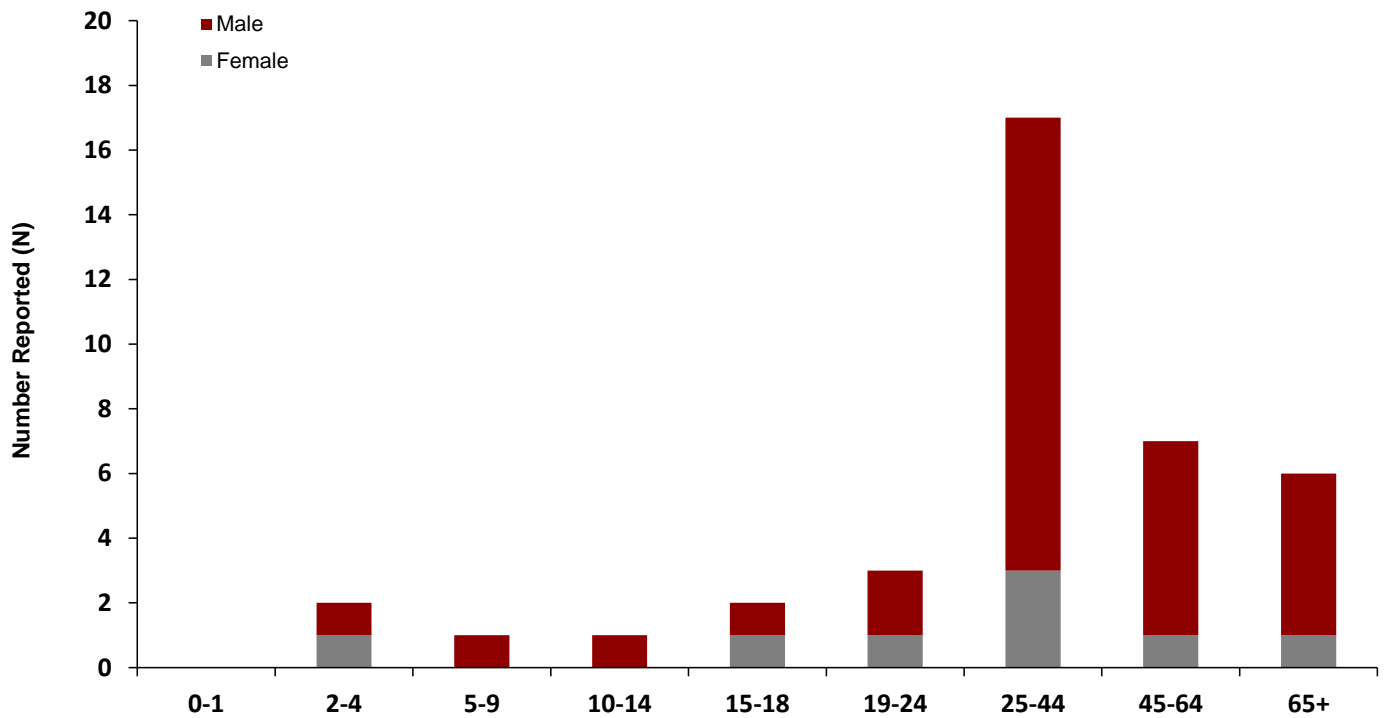
**Figure 1. Daily heat-related illnesses & heat index, Bexar County: March 15 – June 2, 2019<sup>1</sup>**
